St James would like to introduce **Felicity Moran**, who will offer instrumental lessons starting at the beginning of Term 3. Felicity is a music tutor who has worked in local primary and high schools for over a decade and currently tutors students from home. Felicity also directs and conducts a Community Youth Concert Band and the Tweed District Youth Orchestra.

Please see the details below outlining the music tuition program;

LESSONS:

Students can select either private or group lessons.

Group lesson format will be – just piano, just guitar, concert band instruments may be mixed depending on demand but will be taught from the same method so that instruments mix seamlessly. Groups are subject to change at times depending on the developing abilities of the students.

INSTRUMENTS:

Piano

Guitar

Concert band instruments (Flute, Saxophone, Clarinet, Trumpet and Trombone). Students will need to have their own instruments.

COSTS:

\$40 per lesson (half hour) private lesson \$20 per lesson (half hour) group lesson

Lessons fees must be paid directly to Felicity Moran and not the school.

LESSON TIMES:

Lessons will be held in the music room on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday from 12:30 p.m. onwards. Felicity will work with the classroom teachers to establish times, which may change throughout the term.
